



Choosing the right size

Here are some tips to help you measure your child and assist you in buying the correct school uniform size. Taking actual body measurements is more accurate than using age.

Once you have your child's measurements you can check our school uniform size charts to choose the right size.

Measurement shown on the sizing chart indicates the size of the garment, not the child. Shirts and tunics generally be 5-10cm larger on the chest/ bust. Please be aware manufacturers tolerances are + or – 1 to 2 cm.

Shirts and Jacket:

Chest – Measure the chest at the fullest part placing the tape measure under the arms.

Length – Measure from the base of neck to the waist.

Shorts and Skirts

Waist – Measure around the waist at the natural waistline. (smallest part)

Length – Measure from under belly button to desired length.

Tunics/dress

Chest - Measure the chest at the fullest part placing the tape measure under the arms.

Length – Measure from the base of the neck to the middle of the knee.

Hat

Measure from the back of your head bringing the ends together at the centre of forehead right above the eyebrows.

Measuring garments

Chest – Measure around the fullest part of the chest

Body Length – the body length is measured from neck seam to the bottom of the shirt.
